Good morning parents and carers,

I hope everyone is feeling a little more settled this morning after the ACT Government announcement of a 7 day lockdown.

As you are aware our school is closed for the 7 day lockdown. Families should keep their children at home if they can. All ACT public schools will remain open to provide supervision for vulnerable children and for children whose parents cannot work from home.

Teachers and support staff are also required to stay at home, unless they are rostered on as essential workers for supervision.

Please be aware that teachers are not required to provide work to students over this 7 days.

During this period, [home learning resources](#) by year level are available on the Education Directorate's website for students and families to undertake self-directed learning from home during this period.

Our teachers will be spending this time preparing to move to remote learning should the lockdown be extended.

Please note that all school events are cancelled or postponed over this 7 day period. We will provide further details at a later date.
