The following details relate to an educational Incursion to **Constable Kenny- Stay OK Every Day** which is being organised for preschool.

Dates: Tuesday, 20 February 2024 (Term 1, Week 4)

Time: 11.30am to 1.00pm

Purpose of Incursion: ACT Policing's Constable Kenny Koala program is designed to educate child care and primary-aged school children on a range of safety themes, and to encourage them to turn to police for help and advice.

Activities: The children will interact with Constable Kenny, ACT Policing's mascot and his presenter. They will talk to the students about thinking about everyday choices, immediate consequences of actions/decisions and how actions can affect others and themselves.

Group Size: 3 groups of 30 students

Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur on an Incursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent. Parents should warn children of the risk to themselves, to others and to property, of impulsive, wilful or disobedient behaviour.
