Dear parents and carers

I hope everyone is doing as well as possible during these challenging times that we are going through. I'm writing to provide you with the latest information about COVID-19 and ACT public schools.

The Chief Minister has announced that remote learning will continue for the remainder of Term 3, which ends on Friday 17 September. A decision about learning in Term 4 will be made and communicated to families by the end of Week 1 of the holidays (Friday 24 September).

Families should continue to keep their children at home for the rest of Term 3. All ACT public schools will remain open for children of parents who cannot work from home and vulnerable children. Out of school hours care is available for our primary school aged students. All students aged 12 and older attending school for supervised remote learning are required to wear masks.

During this extended period of remote learning, teaching will continue to be delivered online through vehicles such as recorded teaching episodes, live teaching and by students accessing set work or resources provided by their teachers. Taking breaks is important and students should be encouraged to go outside if possible and get some physical activity.

We understand and are aware of the pressures on families at this time, with many parents and carers supervising the remote learning of our primary school students in particular while also working from home. Please prioritise your family's wellbeing and let your child's teacher know if it is not achievable for them to complete all of their set tasks.

I'd also like to acknowledge the strength of our school community. This has been a challenging period for our families and students, and I thank you for your continued support of each other.
