Help me at home by acknowledging when I make safe choices.


LITERACY

To tune into the oral language spoken around us.
To make meaningful connections to the alphabetic code, starting with the recognition of our own names.
To develop our print knowledge by listening to reading, exploring books and borrowing texts from our preschool.
To develop speaking and listening skills when using our imagination and connecting socially with others.



Help me at home by reading to me, noticing how my name looks and engaging in conversations with me to continue to expand my vocabulary.

NUMERACY



To use numbers and counting to explore and explain the world around us.
To notice shapes, patterns, colours and mathematical concepts in our play and experiences.
To use mathematical vocabulary to communicate our thinking and observations.

Help me at home by encouraging me to observe mathematical concepts and engaging in conversations about what we notice.

INQUIRY FOCUS

To explore self-identity and what it means to be a preschooler.
To develop social skills and self-care routines that will support our future.

You can help me at home by encouraging me to dress myself, apply suncream, follow toilet routines independently, including flushing the toilet and washing my hands with soap. I may need reminders about how to share with others and how I could start conversations with friends and peers.
