The following details relate to an educational excursion to use the areas surrounding Amaroo School (map supplied below) which is being organised for all Secondary students during their Health and Physical Education classes in 2024.

**Dates:** HPE classes will access surrounding areas to participate in activities throughout the 2024 school year.

Students will be using the community paths for specific Cross Country practice during weeks 8 to 11 of Term 1 and Week 1 of Term 2.

Time: These activities will occur during students scheduled or timetabled HPE lesson times
